Broadway Gallery is pleased to announce an open call for **PHOTO LETCHWORTH** a new photography competition and exhibition, open to residents of Letchworth and the surrounding area.

The selection panel of Cassie Beadle (Cob Gallery, London), Anstice Oakshott (The Photographers Gallery, London) and photographer Chris Frazer Smith will be choosing 20 finalists whose work will be installed in the main gallery as a supporting exhibition to Cornelia Parker's ***One Day This Glass Will Break***. The winner of the £500 prize, however, will be chosen by the gallery's visitors in a public vote.

Entries for the exhibition will be judged on the following criteria*:

- Experimentation
- Composition
- Subject matter

*Please note that the above criteria are open to interpretation, designed to give applicants freedom of expression and encouragement to experiment.

Please also include a brief biography and a description of the submitted works. The final date for entries is **September 1st, 2019**. The physical work should be no larger than 50 x 70 cm unless alternative arrangements have been agreed with the gallery in advance.
